The **Government of the Republic of Liberia** has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Liberia Urban Resilience Project (LURP)** and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Procurement & Delivery of ICT Equipment to Support MPW, MCC and Capacity Building Interventions**. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through Letter of Credit.

Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding procedures using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "**Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers**" dated **July 2016 and revised November 2017 and August 2018, Revised September 2025 (seventh edition) ("Procurement Regulations")** and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased and collected by interested eligible Bidders at the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **One Hundred States Dollars (US\$100.00)** in cash to the PMU Project Finance Officer.
